## STUDENT / PARENT CONTRACT

This contract is presented to you in order that everyone participating on our Spring Tour understands the guidelines and expectations during our time away from school.

### All school rules apply!

#### **BUS BEHAVIOR**

1. Busses will be boarded by class. (seniors, juniors, sophomores, freshman). Keep the forward seats for the parent chaperones and directors.
2. No loud stereos or portable games.
3. Keep talking confined to the group in your immediate area. Do not scream or shout!
4. Use the restrooms only if absolutely necessary.
5. Do not leave the bus until told to do so.

#### **HOTEL BEHAVIOR**

1. Be considerate at all times!
2. If a problem arises – call your Chaperone or Mr. Wagner. Don't be afraid to seek help.
3. Use only pay phones to call home. The hotel phones (usually turned off) do have a service charge on all calls placed from your room.
4. Running and loud talking in the hallways disturbs others. Don't do it.
5. Vote on (a) room leader(s) to take care of the "key(s)" and be in charge of noise control, etc.
6. Valuables left in your room could be stolen.
7. Never leave your room without checking to see that it is locked and that your room leader has the key.
8. Keep your rooms clean. It is **NOT** housekeeping's job to pick up your trash and dirty clothes.
9. No one is to venture outside the hotel without being with a group.
10. Security guards are not allowed in your room. The only people allowed in rooms are those staying in the room, Mr. Wagner or parent chaperones.
11. Boys are **NOT** allowed in girls rooms and girls are **NOT** allowed in boys rooms. **No Exceptions!**
12. If someone knocks on your hotel door, ask who it is before opening. Make sure you have positively identified the person. If there is a peep hole in the door, use it. Use the security latch to secure your door when you are in the room.
13. If the hotel has pay **TV** movies, do not turn them on or you will have to pay for them (movies will be turned **OFF**, if possible)
14. When we depart, "keys" will be collected.
15. Adhere to the "in-room" and "lights out" times. Lights out means lights off and in bed.

#### **CONCERT BEHAVIOR**

1. Be considerate of the performing group and audience members. Treat them as you would want to be treated.
2. Stay together at all times.
3. Be focused on the performance.
4. Follow directions quickly during rehearsal and performances. **DO NOT TALK!**
5. Adjust to your space quickly.
6. It is mandatory that you support all performing groups, even if you're not performing. Be supportive, but not loud and obnoxious.
7. Have fun and perform to your best ability.

**THE FOUR MUST DO's**

- 1. **Buddy System:** Your personal safety is a priority. We require that you stay with a chaperone or group of at least three people at all times during the tour.
- 2. **Punctuality:** It is imperative to be on time so that the rest of the group does not wait for just one person. If someone is habitually late we will have one of the chaperones stay behind to wait for the tardy person who will then be financially responsible for any transportation costs related to meeting up with the group.
- 3. **Stay together:** Follow your leader closely. Do not lag behind the main group while touring on foot.
- 4. **Schedule:** Know where to be, when to be there, what to have with you, etc. at all times!

**GENERAL**

- 1. **NO** fireworks, snap rocks/poppers or other disruptive "toys".
- 2. **NO** alcohol. **NO** drugs of any type, unless previously approved by Mr. Wagner and your physician. School rules apply to everyone *regardless of age*. Any student caught disregarding this rule **will be sent home COD!** \_\_\_\_\_ **Initial**
- 3. Strangers are to remain strangers! (this **doesn't** include the hosts or other performing groups)
- 4. Do not leave any of your possessions out of sight. **You** are responsible for them. If you leave something somewhere, we are not going back to get it and you'll have to do the phone calling.

**DISCIPLINE**

- 1. **ALL SCHOOL RULES APPLY!**
- 2. All infractions of the above rules will be submitted to Nordhoff Administration. Depending on the level of infraction, off-campus lunch passes, attendances at school events (prom, etc), participation in the department and even graduation may be jeopardized.
